Who doesn't like listening to *Desperado*, *Witchy Woman* or *One of These Nights*? In celebration of these songs, we salute our **HONORARY PEA**, Don Henley.

Born July 22, 1947 in Gilmer, Texas, Henley attended North Texas State University in 1968 and 1969. He left to spend time with his father who was dying from heart and arterial diseases.



In 1970, he moved to Los Angeles to record an album with his band, *Shiloh*; this album was produced by fellow Texan, Kenny Rogers. It was in LA that Henley met Glenn Frey. Both toured as members of Linda Ronstadt's back-up band.

As a result to this, Henley and Frey formed their own group, *Eagles*, in 1971.

A year later the band's first album was release which contained the hit song, *Take It Easy*. Together for almost a decade, Henley and Frey co-wrote most of their famous songs, among them *Hotel California*, *Best of My Love*, *The Last Resort*, *Life in the Fast Lane* and *Wasted Time* to name a few.

During their stint together, the *Eagles* won numerous Grammy Awards and became the most successful rock band of all time. They were the only band to have two best selling albums in the top 15 American best sellers of all time and are among the top 5 overall best selling band of all time in America.

They broke up in 1980 following a difficult tour and increased personal tensions. They reunited in 1994. Henley continues to tour and record with the *Eagles*.
